



CALL TO SOLIDARITY

Close to 10,000 of our colleagues, members of the Centrale des syndicats du Québec (CSQ), will again exercise their right to strike in support of the negotiation for the renewal of the collective agreements in the public and parapublic sectors.

On Thursday, May 13, 2021, members of the *Fédération des enseignantes et enseignants de cégep* (FEC-CSQ), of the *Fédération du personnel professionnel des collèges* (FPPC-CSQ) and of the *Fédération du personnel de soutien de l'enseignement supérieur* (FPSES-CSQ) will thus hold their second strike day. Please note that the college network teachers that are members of the *Confédération des syndicats nationaux* (CSN) will join the unions affiliated with the CSQ for the morning.

We are, of course, calling on the solidarity of all members of the CSQ to support the college network colleagues. Those who can get to the picket lines are invited to check the list of college institutions on strike, at the bottom of this page.

May 10, 2021 actions: we are more than ready for a real negotiation

Faced with the "two-to-three-week" ultimatum given by Québec's Premier, François Legault, to resolve negotiations, the CSQ and its public sector federations pleaded, Monday morning, for the government to release the mandates and the means to conclude a real negotiation allowing to resolve the numerous problems experienced by the education, CEGEPs and health personnel, where a majority of women are employed.

To illustrate its message, that is, that the negotiation isn't over, after receiving offers that were "à coucher dehors" (outlandish), the CSQ organized a symbolic campsite with a motor-home and camping equipment in front of the Treasury Board, in Québec City.

Equipped with camping chairs and sleeping bags, CSQ members repeated that they were more than ready for a real negotiation aimed at enhancing their working conditions, and that they're awaiting a signal from the Treasury Board in that respect.

"Mr. Legault and Ms. LeBel: we are still waiting for a real negotiation allowing the true worth of the thousands of women and men working in public services to be recognized," mentioned the CSQ president, Sonia Ethier.
